REFERENCE OF THE REGULATION: REGULATION ON MEASURES FOR PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES COVID-19

Legal entities and entrepreneurs (employers) who perform activities in the field of retail trade and services in the field of catering, which include the sale of food and beverages, this activity, or the provision of services can perform, or serve customers indoors and in organized gardens in the open - with the application of preventive measures prescribed by this Decree and determined by the act of the employer, in accordance with the law and regulations in the field of safety and health at work.

Legal entities and entrepreneurs referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article are obliged, in relation to employees and users of services, to apply all preventive measures affecting the safety and health of employees and users of services, especially those related to preventing the spread of infectious diseases. 19 (organization of the work process that ensures the maintenance of physical distance, i.e. mutual distance between two persons of at least two meters, mandatory disinfection of furniture, machines, tools and devices for work after the service provided to each individual user, mandatory use of protective equipment or masks by employees - for the provision of outdoor services, as well as additional measures of a limited number of persons in the room, and in the case of less than two meters between users, the provision of services using glass, plastic or similar barriers, mandatory disinfection of rooms and floors, mandatory use of protective equipment. masks and from service users - for the provision of indoor services), and to that effect adopt a special plan for the implementation of measures, as an integral part of the act referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article.

The working hours of catering facilities are limited so that facilities that do not have a garden and night clubs will not work from 21.00 to 06.00 the next day, while facilities that have a garden will not provide catering services in the closed part of the facility from 21.00, and in the open part of the facility (garden) from 01.00 to 06.00 the next day.

Legal entities and entrepreneurs (employers) who sell goods or provide services in shopping centres and similar facilities in which activities in the field of retail trade are performed, and which includes the sale of goods and services in shops that are entered from a larger enclosed space, are obliged are that, in relation to employees and service users, apply all preventive measures that affect the safety and health of employees and service users, especially those related to preventing the spread of infectious diseases COVID-19 (organizing a work process that provides a limited number of people in space, maintaining physical distance, ie mutual distance between two persons of at least two meters, providing services using glass, plastic or similar barriers, mandatory disinfection of rooms and floors, furniture, machines, tools and devices for work after the service is provided to each individual user, mandatory use of protective equipment, ie masks by employees and service users), and that in this sense don are a special plan for the implementation of measures, which is an integral part of the act on risk assessment adopted in accordance with the law and regulations in the field of safety and health at work.

The working hours of shops, shopping centers and other retail trade facilities are limited so that these facilities will not be open from 11 pm to 6 am the next day.
